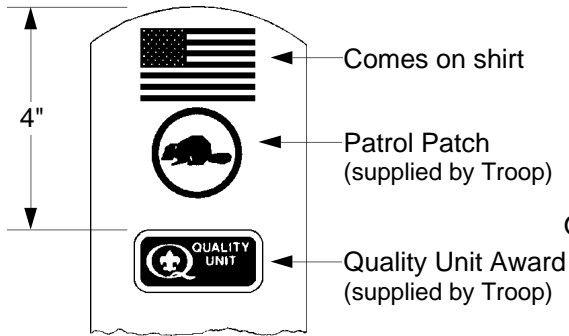


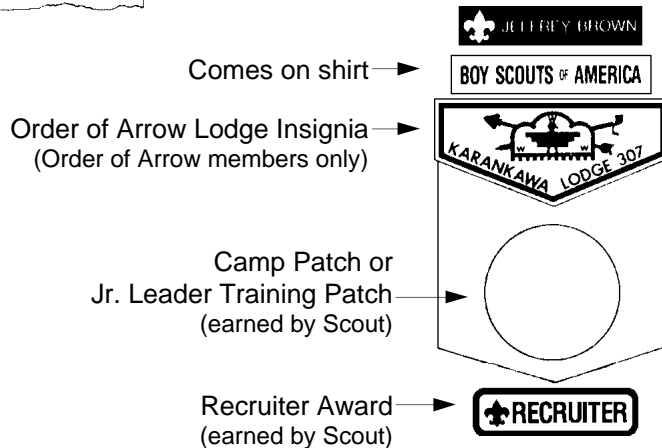
# Boy Scout Insignia Guide

## RIGHT SLEEVE

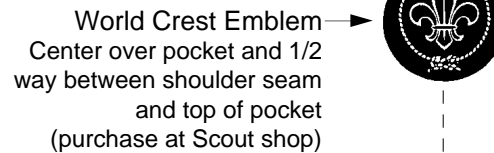


Optional nameplate (Adults only)



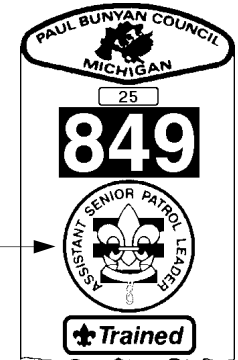
## RIGHT POCKET

Troop Number (available at nominal cost from the Troop)

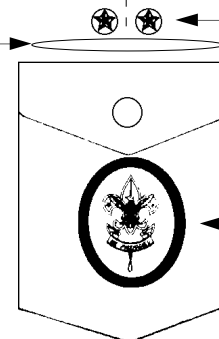
Badge of Office (earned by Scout)



Trained Emblem (earned by Scout)

This area is for religious emblems, embroidered knots, and other medals. See notes.

Service Stars (supplied by Troop) Wear 3/8" above pocket, medals, and knots.

## LEFT POCKET

Red shoulder loops (purchase at Scout shop)

Den Chief Service Award (red, white, & blue, earned by Scout)

Only Den Chiefs

Den Chief Shoulder Cord (blue, gold, & red, earned by Scout)



## NOTES

One Cub Scout, one Boy Scout, and one leader service star (year pin) may be worn simultaneously. Leaders may combine youth and adult tenure into one leader star.

Service star background colors: gold = Cub Scout, green = Boy Scout, blue = adult leader.

Only five medals may be worn at a time, pinned in a single row immediately above the left pocket.

The Trained Leader emblem may be worn only in conjunction with the emblem of office for which basic training has been completed.
